- 1. PURPOSE.** This advisory circular (AC) announces the availability of AC ~~150/5050-3B~~, Planning the State Aviation System.
 - 2. CANCELLATION.** AC ~~150/5050-3A~~, Planning the State Airport System, dated June ~~1972~~, is cancelled.
 - 3. BACKGROUND.** The information presented in AC ~~150/5050-3B~~ is intended primarily for the use of state aviation agencies and their consultants. However, it may prove useful to other state and metropolitan/regional organizations involved in transportation and land use planning, budgetary/fiscal activities, and legislative matters. The individual airport operator and the general public may also find this document helpful. This AC provides national guidance for state airport-heliport system planning and may be used for this purpose pursuant to the provisions of the Airport and Airway Improvement Act of ~~1982~~, as amended by the Airport and Airway Safety and Capacity Expansion Act of ~~1987~~.
