

SELECTED HIGHWAY STATISTICS AND CHARTS -- 1986

MOTOR FUEL - Highway Use of Gasoline up 3.1 Percent; Special Fuels (Diesel) Use up 3.8 Percent

Highway use of motor fuel in 1986 totaled 125.2 billion gallons, an increase of 3.2 percent from 1985. In 1987, highway use of motor fuel is expected to increase by about 1.3 percent. Motor-fuel revenues increased 13.6 percent from 1985, reflecting a number of tax increases which took effect in late 1985 and in 1986. Motor-fuel revenues are expected to increase by about 14.1 percent in 1987, reflecting additional tax rate increases in 1987.

The increase in motor-fuel usage reflects a continued growth in travel and occurred despite an increase in the fuel efficiency of the vehicle fleet from 14.62 MPG in 1985 to 14.68 in 1986.

MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS - Total Motor-Vehicle Registrations Exceed 176 Million in 1986

Motor-vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 171,688,878 in 1985 to 176,191,339 in 1986, an increase of 2.6 percent. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues increased 5.1 percent. Motor-vehicle registrations for 1987 are expected to exceed 1986 by 2.7 percent for a total of 180,989,000. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues are expected to increase by 3.4 percent in 1987.

DRIVER LICENSING - Number of Licensed Drivers up 1.7 Percent

The total of 159.5 million licensed drivers in 1986 reflects an increase of 1.7 percent over 1985. The growth rate for female drivers is 27 percent higher than the rate for male drivers. Total drivers for 1987 are expected to be 1.6 percent higher than in 1986.

HIGHWAY FINANCE - Total Disbursements for Highways Increased by \$5.5 Billion in 1986

Highway-user imposts, consisting of motor-fuel taxes, motor-vehicle taxes and fees, and highway tolls, increased by \$2.0 billion from 1985 to 1986. These revenues totaled \$37.6 billion and accounted for 57.5 percent of total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1986. Total receipts were slightly more than \$65 billion, an increase of 6.7 percent over 1985. Receipts from nonuser sources--general revenue, property taxes, investment income and miscellaneous receipts--totaled \$21.4 billion, a 9.5 percent increase from 1985. Bond proceeds amounted to \$6.3 billion for 1986, an increase of \$1.0 billion over 1985.

Total highway expenditures amounted to \$63.1 billion in 1986, up \$5.5 billion from 1985. Capital outlay increased by \$2.3 billion, or 8.7 percent, to \$28.9 billion. Inflation in highway construction prices declined in 1986 resulting in a real increase of 9.0 percent in highway capital outlay. Expenditures for highway maintenance and traffic services amounted to \$18.1 billion, an increase of \$1.5 billion, or 9.1 percent; however, inflation reduced real expenditures to a 3.9 percent increase over 1985.

Total receipts for highway by all units of government exceeded expenditures by \$2.3 billion in 1986 due largely to bond sales. These monies are expected to result in increased capital outlay in 1987.

For the 50 States and the District of Columbia, highway-user imposts accounted for 74.7 percent of the \$32.5 billion in State highway receipts for 1986. State highway receipts from user fees increased by \$975 million; receipts from nonuser sources increased by \$433 million and accounted for 13 percent of State receipts for highways. Bond proceeds totaled \$3.9 billion, the highest amount recorded by the States for highways, and exceeded 1985 sales by over \$500 million. Bond proceeds exclude refunding. State highway programs totaled \$37.9 billion (excluding grants-in-aid to local governments) for 1986, an increase of \$3.0 billion over 1985. Highway capital outlay--\$22.0 billion--accounted for 58.0 percent of total State expenditures, the same as in 1985.

ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL - Travel up 3.6 Percent

Existing public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1986, totaled approximately 3.88 million miles, an increase of 0.5 percent from 1985.


Highway travel in the United States increased to an estimated 1,838 billion vehicle miles in 1986--an increase of about 3.6 percent from the previous year.

The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 21 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 10 percent of the mileage and carry 70 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 31 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 86 percent of the travel.

MISCELLANEOUS - Expenditures per mile average \$24,910, and \$7,280 per mile for capital outlay and maintenance respectively. State highway-user revenue per 1,000 vehicle miles of travel averaged \$14.96 for all States.
















HIGHWAY EXPENDITURES BY ALL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT







(EXCLUDING TOLL FACILITIES)**



(EXCLUDING TOLL FACILITIES)




STATE HIGHWAY-USER REVENUE PER VEHICLE MILE OF TRAVEL 1986
